'The ground in question is the piece to the right of the LPE office entrance and it is getting bigger and uglier each year. Google it.

It stopped a number of additional cherry trees being planted and looks awful. It could be mown and used for more wild flowers etc.

I have spoken to LPE and in principle they are happy for it to be cleared and put me in touch with the head forester Chris Waskett. He said it would cost about £400 to fell/cut and remove the trees/bramble bushes.

Alan Priest says he can put approx. £250 towards that so I am asking the APC if they could find the rest.

If they can then we can approach LPE and say yes we can fund it so they can approach the Land owners for approval.

We cannot do anything until September because of regulation for cutting hedges etc but that gives us plenty of time to get everything sorted.

This would be hugely beneficial from a visual point of view and the entrance to Aylburton will look great.

Please can you let me know what the APC are willing to do.'
